1. General

Terms & Conditions: Craft Fair at the Art On The Terrace Gallery is a production of the SICC which reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to amend or augment the rules of participation in, and/or these Terms and Conditions of, Craft Fair at the Art On The Terrace Gallery, at any time.

2. Fees and Application

The table fee is \$ _____ per Exhibitor. Exhibitor must be a paid up, member in good standing of SICC. Exhibitor is responsible for all transactions and collecting sales tax. The entire application must be completely filled out, signed, and fees submitted before any allocation of space is made. This application is a contract governed by the laws of New York State. 5. Space Allocation and Placement

SICC reserves the right to limit the space allocated to each exhibitor (6' table space, table/display provided by exhibitor). Special requests regarding location will be considered, but cannot be made a condition of participation. SICC reserves the right to make changes in space assignments and/or fair configuration at any time. All exhibit placements, and the fair design are at the sole discretion of SICC.

6. Space Set-Up

Exhibits must be set up in a professional manner (wrinkle-free, cloth tablecloths long enough to cover boxes, packing materials, etc, beneath table) without presenting a hazard or danger to visitors or participants. Physical space alterations are not permitted. SICC bears no responsibility, whatsoever, for exhibitor's property. Spaces must be set up by opening hour of day of exhibit, and cannot be removed before closing time of that day.

7. Exhibitor Statement and Visuals

Exhibitor grants SICC the non-exclusive right to use exhibitor information, and visuals of works by exhibitor in marketing and advertising materials. Exhibitor credit by name will be given in every possible case. Exhibitor must notify SICC if they do not wish their work to appear in print or publication.

8. Security

SICC does not guarantee exhibitor against loss, theft, or property damage, nor does it imply an assumption of liability for exhibitor's property by the organizers of SICC, nor shall it be construed as grounds for any indemnification whatsoever to exhibitor against loss or theft or otherwise.

9. Responsibility for Exhibitor's Work

SICC is not responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to the exhibitor's property while on display. SICC suggests that exhibitors insure their work privately for adequate protection in all potential situations.

10. Right of Refusal

SICC reserves the right to refuse to display any work of art, and reserves the right to refuse display the work of exhibitors who fail to deliver a signed copy of this exhibition contract.

11. Other

SICC is entitled, in the case of compelling reasons or Acts of God, to postpone, shorten, or extend the exhibition. The organizers of Craft Fair at Art On The Terrace Gallery bear no responsibility whatsoever for the effect (including cancellation of the exhibition) of war, revolution, insurrection, or acts of terrorism. SICC reserves the right to expel from the exhibition any exhibitors who violate the rules, policies, procedures, terms, and/or conditions stated herein and established from time to time by SICC. The laws of the City of New York, State of New York, and the United States of America shall be applicable to these Terms and Conditions and all matters arising out of Exhibitor's participation this event.

12. Amendments

This Agreement may be amended, waived, discharged, modified or terminated only by an instrument in writing signed by both parties and attached to this Agreement.

13. Integration

This Agreement embodies and contains the entire Agreement and understandings of the parties and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of and be enforceable by their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns.

14. Arbitration

In the event a dispute arises under this Agreement, the parties shall confer with all reasonable dispatch and endeavor to arrive at a solution; failing agreement, the dispute shall be submitted to a single arbitrator either agreed to by the parties, or appointed by the American Arbitration Association, who shall decide the dispute under the rules of the Association; and any decision by an arbitrator shall be final and binding upon both parties.

15. Duration

This Agreement shall commence upon the date of signing. Neither party may terminate this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party.

16. Hold Harmless Agreement

The Exhibitor agrees to hold the organizers of Craft Fair at the Art On The Terrace Gallery, the organizers' Board, staff, and volunteers harmless for any damage, theft or loss of property. The Exhibitor understands the risk of exhibiting artwork, and accepts it.
